- be responsible for diagnosis and treatment of primary care and referral patients, routine health and production services for ruminant producers under guidance of the LVS Director
- ensure all client services are provided at a high standard including accurate and timely billing, record keeping, vehicle stock control and client follow-up
- ensure vehicles and equipment are handled with care, kept clean, and are appropriately maintained
- practice and promote professional standards of biosecurity, to track and keep abreast of potential infectious disease outbreak
- provide assistance in training of undergraduate and postgraduate veterinary students rotating through the LVS unit under the guidance of the Director LVS (HEO 6)
- provide supervision and training of undergraduate and postgraduate veterinary students rotating through the LVS unit (HEO7)
