### **RESIDENT/INTERN (0,8 fte)**

**A vacancy** exists in the Veterinary Pathology Diagnostic Center (VPDC). The VPDC provides teaching of DVM students (year 1-6), offers service in diagnostic pathology (companion, farm, exotic animals and wildlife) and performs patient-oriented research.

**The pathology residency** of the Department of Pathobiology is an in-service training program in veterinary pathology that can lead to the certifying examination of the European College of Veterinary Pathologists (ECVP). It covers all species from wild birds to cattle. During the residency the candidate shall acquire competences and expertise in the broad field of veterinary pathology, which will allow the successful pursuit of a career in diagnostic pathology, research, and/or teaching.

#### **Duties**

Your tasks will consist mainly of participation, with increasing independence, in diagnostic and teaching activities. In addition, you will collaborate in research projects in one of focus areas of the Faculty, resulting in publication of at least two peer-reviewed manuscripts in the area of veterinary pathology. The position has many contacts with veterinarians, both in the field of clinical medicine and research, as well as biomedical researchers.

#### **Qualifications**

We are looking for a veterinarian with proven interest in the field of veterinary pathology. You are able to organize your work efficiently and independently. You have great dedication and perseverance and have good social and communicative skills. If you are not a native speaker, you are prepared to learn Dutch within a reasonable period of time (1 year).

#### **Conditions**

We offer a temporary contract for 1 year with the option for extensions for a total of up to 4 years depending on performance. Starting date is 1-5-2019. Salary is according to experience and within scale 10 according to the CAO of the Dutch Universities.
