The congress program will also include the following awards

- Award for the **Best Poster sponsored by the French Society of Toxicologic Pathology (SFPT)**: The recipient will receive a certificate and a cash prize of 1,000€. Please find below the information how to apply.
- **IATP Charles Capen Trainee Award**, rewarding a major contribution in toxicologic pathology by a student or trainee: The IATP funds the award in the amount of 750 US\$ which can be used to attend a conference of a Society of Toxicologic Pathology or related meeting. - **IATP Food Safety Scientific Award**, sponsored by the IATP, rewarding a food-related scientific contribution by a young investigator or trainee: The award consists of a certificate and a check in the amount of U.S. dollars market equivalent of 100,000¥. - **ESTP Publication Award**: The ESTP funds the award for a toxicologic pathology-related scientific contribution by a young investigator or trainee with a certificate, a prize money of 1,500€, the registration fee and travel costs (economy flight booked by our congress organizer) for the upcoming ESTP congress. With this endowment it is attempted to promote cooperation between Universities and industry and to motivate young scientists in toxicological pathology and related fields. - **Chirukandath Gopinath Lecture Award**, an engraved glass award, is sponsored by the British Society of Toxicological Pathology (BSTP). The awarded speaker is an internationally recognized scientist. The lecture is to be on a topic in pathology relevant to practicing toxicological pathologists. The speaker is an internationally recognized scientist and is chosen by the scientific organizing committee and approved by the BSTP council.

The SFPT Best Poster Award

Since 2010, the SFPT sponsors the Best Poster Award selected by the Poster Committee with a certificate and a cash prize of 1,000€. The aim of the SFPT is to help scientists to share their work and results to their scientific peers and to favor direct contact during the poster sessions. All posters with pathology content are eligible; however toxicologic pathology topics will be favored as well as a young colleague.

IATP Charles Capen Trainee Award

Rewarding a major contribution in toxicologic pathology by a student or trainee.

The Charles Capen Trainee Award given by the International Academy of Toxicologic Pathology (IATP) recognizes Dr. Charles Capen and his legacy as a researcher, teacher, and mentor to the pathology and toxicology communities spanning more than four decades. Dr. Capen was recognized worldwide as an exceptional leader in veterinary and biomedical research. He was a highly regarded mentor to graduate students and postdoctoral scientists. His students and trainees are now leaders throughout academia, government, and industry and have contributed significantly to his reputation as an outstanding teacher and research mentor.

The IATP funds an award in the amount of 750 US\$ which can be used by the successful applicant to attend a conference of a Society of Toxicologic Pathology or related meeting. Funds may be used for travel and/or meeting registration or any other related expenses.

The successful applicant must be a pathology, toxicology or toxicologic pathology trainee. A trainee is defined as an individual working on an academic degree, in a training or residency program, or in a postdoctoral training position. The applicant must present a poster at the congress in the field of toxicologic pathology including but not limited to: Research contributing to public safety as it relates to the adverse health effects of xenobiotics; Establishing test methods and standards that enhance the field of toxicologic pathology; Developing new or novel uses of toxicologic pathology in safety research.

IATP Food Safety Scientific Award

The IATP is pleased to announce the implementation of the Food Safety Scientific Award sponsored by a grant from San-Ei Gen F.F.I. The award recognizes a food-related poster presentation, oral presentation, or scientific publication by a young investigator or trainee. The successful applicant will have demonstrated achievements in food-related toxicologic pathology including but not limited to:

- Research contributing to food additive safety as it relates to the health effects of foods and food ingredients;
- Establishing test methods and standards that enhance the field of toxicologic pathology that are applicable to food; and/or
- Developing new or novel uses of toxicologic pathology in food safety research.

The award consists of a certificate and a check in the amount of U.S. dollars market equivalent of 100,000 ¥.

Who can apply:

The applicant must be a pathology, toxicology or toxicologic pathology trainee. A trainee is defined as an individual working on an academic degree, in a training or residency program, or in a postdoctoral training position. The applicant must present a poster at the congress with a food-related scientific contribution.

ESTP Publication Award

The European Society of Toxicologic Pathology was founded in 2002. With more than 300 active members, it represents the discipline of Toxicologic Pathology in Europe. Since it is our goal to promote the importance of toxicologic pathology as an independent, specialized area, the ESTP has traditionally been awarding prizes for outstanding Thesis or Papers in this discipline. These awards have now been combined.

Who can apply:

We ask for nominations of impactful Thesis or Publications in the field of toxicological pathology that were published throughout 2018 or 2019. Applications for the award will be evaluated by the ESTP award committee, and the best thesis/paper will be honored with 1,500 €. The award will be presented at the 2019 ESTP annual meeting in Cologne, Germany. It is mandatory that the recipient attends the awards ceremony. The registration fee will be waived, and travel costs will be covered by ESTP.

The sponsored lecture was called the BSTP Chirukandath Gopinath Lecture in tribute to one of the founder members of the BSTP whose name is recognized by toxicological pathologists all over the world. The lecture is to be on a topic in pathology relevant to practicing toxicological pathologists. The speaker is an internationally recognized scientist and is chosen by the scientific organizing committee and approved by the BSTP council.
