The caseload consists largely of canine and feline samples and includes a high proportion of samples from referral hospitals including various specialties (e.g. oncology, internal medicine, soft tissue surgery, ophthalmology, neurology and dermatology).

Responsibilities include preparation of high-quality reports on histopathological findings, integrating clinical data and interpretation of adjunctive testing such as immunohistochemistry, liaising with clinical colleagues and advising the histology technical staff.
