Position of assistant in veterinary pathology

Start date: September 15, 2022

The Department of Veterinary Pathology of Liège University (Belgium) is seeking a **veterinary pathologist** to join our team of assistants and participate in the development of our diagnostic services and research activities. The position involves a 50% commitment to teaching activities and a 50% commitment to service (diagnosis) and research activities. The laboratory receives animals for necropsy and surgical specimens from Clinical Departments, the Wildlife diseases surveillance network and research laboratories of the Faculty and from veterinary field practitioners. Electron microscopy and digital pathology (Hamamatsu slide scanner) are available. The laboratory also performs molecular analyses for clinicians and private laboratories, based on PCR and next-generation sequencing.

The teaching activities consist of the supervision of undergraduate students during the necropsy clinics and histopathology practical exercises. The Department is highly active in the study of host-pathogen interactions of several viral diseases, based on in vitro and in vivo models. It also collaborates with the Clinical and non-Clinical Departments of the Faculty on several research topics. Assistants are encouraged to undertake a PhD program.

Candidates must have a **DVM degree**, excellent verbal and written communication skills, and ability to meet new challenges. Demonstrated experience in veterinary pathology, advanced training in pathology (DESV), eligibility to sit the ECVP/ACVP exam, an ACVP or ECVP diploma or a PhD will be considered as major assets. **Fluency in French is mandatory.** Possibility to evolve to a permanent position, provided the candidate holds a PhD degree.
