The Position:

Duties and Responsibilities:

Requirements:

- Veterinary degree suitable for registration in Australia.

- Previous experience (minimum 2 years) in diagnostic veterinary pathology is preferred. Applicants with less diagnostic experience but appropriate qualifications will also be considered.
