Case No. 10 Organ: liver, small intestine		
Species: Squirre	monkey (Saimirii sciureus)	male, adult
Case history: Several animals of a zoo colony died: some with diarrhoea, other animals sudden death		
<u>Gross pathology:</u> severe erosive haemorrhagic gastritis and enteritis, hyperplasia of mesenterial lymph nodes, multiple necrotic foci in liver and spleen, ascites,		
Microscopical description:		
bacterial colonies		
Pathohistological diagnosis:		
enteritis, hepatitis, splenitis: acute, necrotising, severe		
Aetiology/Comment:	Yersinia pseudotuber	culosis
