Case No. 11 Organ: lung	
Species: Marmoset (Callithrix jacchus)	female, infant six weeks
<u>Case history:</u> Breeding colony with 700 animals. This animal was found dead.	
Gross pathology: severe purulent pneumonia with mu abscesses; fibrinous pleuritis, epicarditis and pericardit necrosis of liver, splenomegaly	
Microscopical description:	
Pathohistological diagnosis:	
Bronchopneumonia, fibrinopurulent, focally necrotising, subacute, severe	
Aetiology/Comment: Bordetella bronchise	eptica
