Case No. 15 Organ: liver, spleen

Species: Rhesus monkey (*M. mulatta*) male, adult

<u>Case history:</u> Experimental SIV infection, Animal developed severe signs of an immunodeficiency one year after onset of the infection. Recurrent diarrhoea, anorexia, apathy,

<u>Gross pathology:</u> Mesenterial lymph node: severe hyperplasia; liver: no abnormality; spleen: mild follicular hyperplasia; severe fibrosing pleuritis (visceral, parietal); valvular endocarditis right ventricle; severe acute gastritis and enteritis;

Microscopical description:

Accumulations of foamy macrophages

Pathohistological diagnosis:

Hepatitis, splenitis: chronic, granulomatous

Aetiology/Comment:

Mycobacterium avium-intracellulare complex
