Case No. 15	Organ: liver, spleen
Species: Rhesus monkey (<i>M. mulatta</i>)	male, adult
Case history: Experimental SIV infection, Animal developed severe signs of an immunodeficiency one year after onset of the infection. Recurrent diarrhoea, anorexia, apathy,	
Gross pathology: Mesenterial lymph node: severe hyperplasia; liver: no abnormality; spleen: mild follicular hyperplasia; severe fibrosing pleuritis (visceral, parietal); valvular endocarditis right ventricle; severe acute gastritis and enteritis;	
Microscopical description:	
Accumulations of foamy macrophages	
Pathohistological diagnosis:	
Hepatitis, splenitis: chronic, granulomatous	
Aetiology/Comment:	
<i>Mycobacterium avium-intracellulare</i> complex
