Case No. 18 Organ: liver, kidney

Species: Marmoset (Callithrix jacchus) male, juvenile

Case history: Private husbandry, three animals died, apathy, low body temperature.

Gross pathology: liver, lymph nodes: hyperaemia, moderate; no other gross pathology;

Microscopical description:

"bacterial accumulations"

Pathohistological diagnosis:

Hepatitis, peracute, with focal periportal necrosis. Nephritis, peracute, with focal tubular necrosis.

Aetiology/Comment: Pasteurella multocida
