Case No. 20 Organ: skin from the cheek

Species: Cotton top tamarin (Saguinus oedipus) male, adult

<u>Case history:</u> Animal from a zoological garden; sudden death without clinical signs.

<u>Gross pathology:</u> lung: alveolar oedema; splenomeagly; right cheek: severe lesions with necrotic tissue;

## Pathohistological diagnosis:

Dermatitis, Panniculitis, ulcerative, necrotising, chronic active, severe, involvement of adjacent muscle structures, foreign material

Aetiology/Comment: Noma: no specific aetiology

immunosuppression

malnutrition

poor oral hygiene
