Case No. 21 Organ: skin, abdominal region

Species: Cynomolgus monkey (M. fascicularis) male, adult

<u>Case history:</u> Experimental animal (xenotransplantation, kidney); died eleven days post operationem due to acute vascular rejection

<u>Gross pathology:</u> severe signs of vascular rejection (kidney) and corresponding reactions in several organs;

Microscopical description:

"inflammatory cells", bacteria (all sections), mycotic structures (some sections)

Pathohistological diagnosis:

Dermatitis and panniculitis, subacute, necrotising, superficially erosive, calcifying; calicification of adjacent muscle structures

Aetiology/Comment:

Wound healing under immunosuppression: (Bacteria, Candida albicans)
