Case No. 22 Organ: liver, lung

Species: Squirrel monkey (Saimiri sciureus) male, adult

<u>Case history:</u> Zoological garden: several animals died suddenly without clinical signs.

<u>Gross pathology:</u> lung: alveolar and interstitial oedema, severe; interstitial emphysema, severe; kidney and liver: mild petechial haemorrhages;

Microscopical description:

Parasitic structures (rare): parasitophorous vacuole with tachyzoites

Pathohistological diagnosis:

Pneumonia, interstitial, acute, mild. Hepatitis, interstitial with focal necrosis, mild to moderate.

Aetiology/Comment: Toxoplama gondii
