






Skeletal muscle.

One sample: unaffected.

The other sample: diffuse lesion.




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Myofiber loss.

Loss of cell details, hyperacidophilia, cytoplasmic invasion by heterophils: acute myofiber necrosis.



- H- Hyaline fibers: rounded, separated from neighbours, hypereosinophilic.
- M- Loss of cell details, cytoplasmic invasion by macrophages: subacute myofiber necrosis.



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Satellite cell activation, presence of myoblasts (mononucleated, hypochromatic nucleus with a prominent nucleolus): attempt at regeneration.



Interstitium: macrophages, heterophils, lymphocytes > oedema.

N6. Turkey/ diagnosis





Skeletal muscle, acute diffuse marked myofiber necrosis (myopathy) with macrophage infiltration and satellite cell activation (onset estimated 3 to 5 days before sampling).

Etiology: monensin toxicity.
