Case No. 24 Organ: small intestine, liver

Species: Guereza (Colobus guereza)

female, adult

<u>Case history:</u> Zooological garden: Two days with severely disturbed general conditions, diarrhoea;

<u>Gross pathology:</u> liver: severe hepatitis, mulitfocal abscesses, hepatomegaly, fibrotic perihepatitis and focal peritonitis; lymphatic tissues: hyperplasia, severe; large and small intestine: signs of subacute enteritis; kidney: interstitial nephritis, mild;

#### Microscopical description:

PAS + parasites

#### Pathohistological diagnosis:

Enteritis, ulcerative, diphtheroid, necrotising, subacute, severe. Hepatitis, chronic active, multifocally necrotizing, severe.

### Aetiology/Comment:

Entamoeba histolytica

- PAS, Giemsa
- PCR
