Case No. 26 Organ: intestine

Species: Rhesus monkey (M. mulatta)

male, adult

<u>Case history:</u> Animal from a vaccine study and experimental SIV infection (5 month p. i.); four months p.i.: animal developed recurrent diarrhoea, which was resistent to appropriate therapy

<u>Gross pathology:</u> heart: suspicion of cardiomyopathy; lung: interstitial pneumonia, severe; gall bladder: enlargement of the bile duct with thickened wall; intestinal tract: signs of diarrhoea; stomach: thickened wall

## Microscopical description:

Parasites (rare)

## Pathohistological diagnosis:

Colitis, chronic, mild,

Aetiology/Comment:

Giardia lamblia syn. intestinalis Trichomonas sp.
