


NON TUMORAL AVIAN VIRAL DISEASES WITH INCLUSION BODIES



Multifocal to coalescent importante epidermal hyperplasia Hyperkeratosis with severe necrosis and exsudate (scabs) Dermal inflammatory infiltrate




V 7: Wild pigeon, adulte, skin (digit)



Severe, subacute, multifocal, exsudative and hyperplastic dermatitis with voluminous intracytoplasmic acidophilic viral inclusion bodies: Cutaneous Avian Poxvirosis (Fowl Pox)

NON TUMORAL AVIAN VIRAL DISEASES WITH INCLUSION BODIES

V 6: Hen, 52 weeks old, Larynx



Voluminous, irregular, intracytoplasmic acidophilic inclusions bodies (Bollinger's bodies)

Epithelial Hyperplasia, epidermal Metaplasia Hyperhemia and Inflammation, Moderate exsudate

Conclusion:

Severe, subacute, multifocal, hyperplastic (and exsudative) Laryngitis with voluminous intracytoplasmic acidophilic viral inclusion bodies : Mucosal Avian Poxvirosis (Fowl Pox)

NON TUMORAL AVIAN VIRAL DISEASES WITH INCLUSION BODIES

Avian Poxvirosis: Conclusion

Same gross and histological lesions in every avian species

- Cutaneous form and/or mucosal form
- K Histology: Epithelial Hyperplasia and Metaplasia with ± severe dermal and exsudative Inflammation
- Voluminous intracytoplasmic acidophilic inclusion bodies: Bollinger's bodies
