Case No. 3 Organ: optic nerve

Species: Rhesus monkey (M. mulatta) | male, adult

<u>Case history:</u> Experimental SIV infection within vaccine trials. Animal developed severe signs of an immunodeficiency five months after onset of the infection.

<u>Gross pathology:</u> Numerous organs presented lesions due to different opportunistic infectious agents. Eyes: no abnormality detected.

Neuritis, multifocal, subacute, mixed cell infiltration, intranuclear basophilic inclusions

Aetiology/Comment: Simian Virus (SV) 40
