00-1705

Tissue: Liver

Large distended vein with variable thickening of vein muscular wall.

Loss of lobular architecture

Portal tracts characterized by loss of portal vein profiles,

biliary hyperplasia,

arteriolar hyperplasia

edema

Central veins have distended lymphatics

Diffuse hepatocellular atrophy

Focal areas of sinusoidal dilation

Diagnosis: A-V fistula
