Case No. 27 Organ: intestine, liver

Species: Rhesus monkey (M. mulatta)

male, adult

<u>Case history:</u> Animal with an experimental SHIV infection; euthanised four months p. i. with recurrent diarrhoea

<u>Gross pathology:</u> spleen: follicular hyperplasia, mild; small intestine: filled with very fluid content; no further abnormalities;

Microscopical description:

parasites

Pathohistological diagnosis:

Cholangitis, chronic, proliferative, eosinophilic; Enteritis, chronic, with severe villous atrophy;

Aetiology/Comment:

Cryptosporidium parvum • immunodeficiency!
