Tissue ID: Liver

Lobular architecture is intact

Sinusoids contain pleomorphic cells with single to multiple nuclei of variable size.

Cytoplasm is pale eosinophilic, foamy and abundant

Mitotic figures are common and often bizarre

Canalicular plugging is common

Loss of hepatocytes in some centrilobular areas (secondary to anemia?)

Pigment is scattered within Kupffer cells

Diagnosis: Malignant histiocytosis with canalicular cholestasis
