Case No. 30 Organ: liver

Species: Cynomolgus monkey (M. fascicularis) male, adult

<u>Case history:</u> Control animal; animal developed abdominal enlargement; radiology: tumour mass liver; euthanasia; no clinical signs

<u>Gross pathology:</u> liver: severe hepatomegaly, severe proliferative hepatitis, cystic transformations, multiple nodules; mesenteric lymph nodes: hyperplasia; pleura: nodules and fibrosing pleuritis; lung: single nodule (diameter 4 cm); pancreas: adhesive to adjacent small intestinal loops, fibrosing peritonitis

Microscopical description:

Fertile cysts with protoscolices

Pathohistological diagnosis:

Hepatitis, chronic, proliferative, with multiple cysts, necrosis, calcification, protoscolices

Aetiology/Comment: Echinococcus multilocularis
