### Summer School 2008 – Inflammation Case 1

#### Case 07-140

- 2.5 yr male Beagle dog
  - Bile duct catheter surgically implanted for PK studies
  - “Small liver” observed at necropsy
- 
- Histologic section: liver through hilus including extrahepatic (common?) bile duct, gall bladder, pancreas, lymph nodes, blood vessels
  - Primary changes: chronic ulcerative and proliferative inflammation of bile duct (choledochitis) associated with suture material (iatrogenic).
  - Secondary changes: secondary biliary cirrhosis; lymph node sinus histiocytosis with erythrophagocytosis, haemosiderosis and bile acid, bilirubin and/or lipofuscin pigment, plasmacytosis, edema.
