ZH4, Porcine	points
Small intestine:	
Adhered multifocally to the surface enterocytes multiple coccoid to rod-shaped	
bacteria are visible. The surface enterocytes are intact, the goblet cells normal in	
appearance and in the crypt cells few mitotic figures can be seen.	
In the lamina propria few numbers of plasma cells, lymphocytes and only single	
neutrophils are visible.	
Name of the Disease: Enterotoxigenic colibacillosis
