Stomach:	1
The gastric mucosa is markedly <u>hyperplastic with prominent mucosal folds</u> and the	1
lamina propria stongly edematous. Multifocally to diffusely in the stomach lumen	1
cellular debris, fibrin and mostly attached to the luminal epithelial cells as well as at	1
the apical surface of the epithelial cells of gastric glands large amounts of 3 to 5	
micrometer big. round oocysts are visible (interpreted as cryptosporidia). Only few	3
chief cells are still visible and most of them are replaced by mucous neck cells and	2
superficial epithelial cells (atrophy). There are nests of hyperplastic branching	1
glands extending deep into the lamina propria. Diffusely in the lamina propria	1
moderate to large amounts of <u>lymphocytes and plasmacells</u> are visible. Small	2
amounts of lightly eosinophilic material (mucus) is visible in the glands.	1
Diagnosis:	
Moderate to severe multifocal to diffuse gastric hyperplasia (mucosal neck	
hyperplasia) and severe diffuse gastric edema with large amounts of cryptosporidial	3
oocysts	
Mild lymphoplasmacellular gastritis	1
