Description:

Generalized parenchymal involvement Intra-alveolar exudates Type II cell Hyperplasia Presence of encapsulated organisms Organization and Clarity: Based on description of organism and description of lesions in context of microscopic anatomy

Morphologic Diagnosis:

Diffuse Non-Suppurative Interstitial Pneumonia with intralesional fungal organisms

Cause: Pneumocystis carinii
