Species: Golden lion tamarin (Leontopithecus rosalia chrysopygus)			female, adult
Case history: Zoological garden, apathy, gasping, sudden death			
<u>Gross pathology:</u> abdominal cavity: foreign material (ingesta?); mesenterial lymph nodes: hyperplasia, severe; liver: steatosis, severe; gall bladder, pancreas, stomach: chronic adhesive peritontis; lung: alveolar oedema, severe; hyperaemia, severe			
Microscopical description:			
Pathohistological diagnosis:			
Hepatitis, interstitial, chronic, with haemosiderosis and icterus, lipidosis. Cholecystitis, catarrhal, fibrinopurulent, subacute to chronic, with choleliths.
