Case 18) S 2113/92: Tissue from a GOAT

Cerebellum: There is a mild leptomeningeal and perivascular infiltration with lymphocytes partly extending into the neuronal parenchyma. Rarely there are eosinophilic cytoplasmic small inclusions within neurons.

Morphologic diagnosis:

Cerebellum: Meningo-encephalitis, multifocal, lymphocytic, mild, acute with intracytoplasmic inclusion bodies

Etiology:

Rabies virus
