Case No. 43 Organ: large intestine	
Species: Saddleback tamarin (Saguinus fuscicollis)	female, adult
<u>Case history:</u> Private husbandry: animal died after one week of illness; anorexia, diarrhoea, veterinary treatments without effect; suspicion: hepatitis	
<u>Gross pathology:</u> lymph nodes: systemic hyperplasia, moderate; lung: alveolar oedema, severe; liver: hepatopathy, severe; kidney: interstitial nephritis, moderate; large intestine: chronic colitis, severe;	
Microscopical description:	
Pathohistological diagnosis:	
Colitis, cystic, chronic = Colitis cystica profunda
