Slide 7. Snake. Skin.

MD:

- Dysekdyosis
- Mild acute heterophilic dermatitis

Key features:

- Several layers of keratinized skin (Dysekdyosis)
- Disseminated hyperkeratosis / parakeratosis in the scute folds
- Mild infiltration with heterophils
- Bacterial colonies in the keratin layers
- Exocytosis
