Slide 9. Snake. Liver.

MD: Multifocal pyogranulomatous hepatitis with intralesional acid-fast bacilli

Aetiology: Mycobacterium sp. (M. marinum, M. cheloni, M. thamnopheos)

DD: other bacterial infection (*E. coli, S. marcescens, P. testudinis, Salmonella, M. morganii*); migrating parasite larvae

Key features:

- Disseminated foci of inflammation composed of accumulation of epithelioid macrophages
- · surrounding a central core composed of necrotic material and heterophils
- · Surrounded by a fibrous capsule
- ZN stain: acid-fast bacilli
