Case No. 6 | Organ: liver

Species: Goeldi's monkey (Callimico goeldii) male, adult

<u>Case history:</u> Zoo colony with new world monkeys. Three pygmy marmosets (*Callithrix pygmea*) and one Goeldi's monkey (*Callimico goeldii*) died over a period of nine months. Short period of unspecific illness (fever, apathia, ataxia).

<u>Gross pathology:</u> Generalised jaundice, hepatomegaly, splenomegaly, lymph node swelling, alveolar oedema.

Microscopical description:

Acidophilic bodies (apoptotic hepatocytes)

Pathohistological diagnosis:

Hepatitis, multifocal, necrotising, severe

Aetiology/Comment: Arenavirus: LCMV
