Case No. 7 Organ: CNS	
Species: Baboon (Papio hamdryas)	female, adult
<u>Case history:</u> Experimental intracerebral application of a vaccine, animals were euthanised 20 days after infection. Clinical signs: apathy, somnolence, anorexia, progressive loss of motoric coordination.	
<u>Gross pathology:</u> No obvious changes (focal alterations at application site)	
Microscopical description:	
Pathohistological diagnosis:	
Encephalitis, nonsuppurative, moderate, with gliosis and neuronal degeneration
