Species: Rhesus monkey (<i>M. mulatta</i>) male, ad		male, adult
Case history: Experimental SIV infection. Euthanised due to experimental protocol. No clinical signs of any disease.		
Gross pathology: mild alveolar edema and emphysema, no further findings.		
Microscopical description:

Gastritis, chronic, diffuse, moderate, with single follicles
