Case 8. nr T8A1 or A2 (N671/01) Tissue from a cat

Description: Cross section of the thoracolumbar and cauda equine spinal cord including spinal roots and ganglia.

Spinal roots and ganglia are infiltrated by a neoplastic lymphoid cell population. It shows a multifocal or diffuse infiltrative pattern.

Compressive lesions in spinal nervous tissue: neuronal loss and death, spongiosis, gliosis, wallerian degeneration.

Morphologic diagnosis: Metastatic Lymphoma
