#### Your job

Your job as a veterinary pathologist with us is challenging and multifaceted.

- You will participate in teaching students of veterinary medicine, residents as well as students from other disciplines.
- Furthermore, you perform gross and histopathology examinations on a broad variety of species and in that role you are in contact with private veterinary practitioners as well as board certified veterinary clinical specialists.
- You also will perform scientific research in cooperation with partners within the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine and other institutes. These activities are performed in a group of veterinary pathologists and supporting staff.

#### Your qualifications

- You are a veterinarian graduated from a university recognized by the European Union and are a diplomate of either the European or American College of Veterinary Pathologists, with extensive experience in veterinary pathology.
- You also hold a PhD, preferably on a subject closely related to the current areas of research of the Division of Pathology, and you have a track of successful acquisition of research funding in cooperation with research partners, and have a broad network in which you have performed your research activities.
- Passing on knowledge and skills in veterinary pathology to students, residents and colleagues gives you energy, and you are willing to acquire a university teaching qualification.
- As a team player, you are able to motivate and stimulate people around you.
- Experience in diagnostic veterinary pathology and leadership qualities are a pre. You also have a keen interest in digital pathology.
- You are fluent in Dutch and English, both in speaking as well as in writing.

#### Our offer

A 12-month position with the prospect of permanent employment; a 36 to 40-hour working week (full-time position), salary within scale 11 to 12 of the Collective Labour Agreement for Dutch Universities, depending on experience; 8% holiday pay and an end-of-year bonus of 8.3%; a pension scheme, partially paid parental leave and flexible working conditions.

The Veterinary Pathology Diagnostic Centre is an essential part of the Division of Pathology, and provides diagnostic services on many different species including companion animals, farm animals, endemic and exotic mammals (including marine mammals), birds, amphibia, reptiles and fish. These services are primarily requested by veterinarians, zoos and governmental bodies.

The department Biomolecular Health Sciences of the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine creates, collects and provides knowledge on function and dysfunction of (animal) cells, tissues and organs. Within the department, the Division of Pathology focusses on the mechanisms of disease as a basis of diagnosis and treatment.
