Role description

- Contributing to the growth of the Certificate in Forensic Veterinary Pathology and promoting its activities
- Actively discuss matters on the agenda for the Committee meeting
- Acting as a voting member in decisions of the Committee during meetings
- Participating in the selection process of CFVP candidates who submit their applications
- Critically examining cases submitted by candidates assigned for evaluation and providing feedback
- Discussing cases submitted by candidates with other members of the Committee
- Actively participating in the round table stage of the certification process
- Contributing to training initiatives of the CFVP within ECVP/ESVP Congress and beyond

Certification as ECVP-CFVP is required to be eligible for membership of the CFVP Committee.

Committee members are generally appointed for a 3-year period. An extension of term of up to 2 years is possible.
