<b>Case No. 11</b>	<b>Organ: lung</b>
<b>Species: Marmoset (<i>Callithrix jacchus</i>)</b>	<b>female, infant six weeks</b>
<b><u>Case history:</u></b> Breeding colony with 700 animals. This animal was found dead.	
<b><u>Gross pathology:</u></b> severe purulent pneumonia with multiple small abscesses; fibrinous pleuritis, epicarditis and pericarditis; focal necrosis of liver, splenomegaly	
<b><u>Microscopical description:</u></b>	
<b><u>Pathohistological diagnosis:</u></b> <b>Bronchopneumonia, fibrinopurulent, focally necrotising, subacute, severe</b>	
<b><u>Aetiology/Comment:</u></b> <b>Bordetella bronchiseptica</b>
