Case No. 14	Organ: stomach
Species: Rhesus monkey (<i>M. mulatta</i>)	male, adult
<u>Case history:</u> Experimental SIV infection, no clinical signs, nine month p. i. euthanised	
<u>Gross pathology:</u> Lymphatic tissues: mild hyperplasia, mild hepatomegaly, severe acute partly erosive gastritis, moderate acute enteritis (small intestine);	
<u>Microscopical description:</u> <p style="text-align: center;">„spirils“</p>	
<u>Pathohistological diagnosis:</u> <p style="text-align: center;">Gastritis, chronic, follicular, moderate</p>	
<u>Aetiology/Comment:</u>	Helicobacter spec.: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>H. pylori</i>, <i>H. heilmannii</i>• Warthin Starry, IHC
