Case No. 17	Organ: liver
Species: Marmoset (<i>Callithrix jacchus</i>)	male, adult
Case history: Breeding colony with 700 animals. This animal was found dead.	
Gross pathology: splenomegaly, hepatomegaly, interstitial nephritis, mild acute enteritis	
Microscopical description:	
Pathohistological diagnosis: Hepatitis, acute, multifocally necrotising, severe; intracellular pigment, haemosiderosis, mild;	
Aetiology/Comment: Listeria monocytogenes
