<b>Case No. 18</b>	<b>Organ: liver, kidney</b>
<b>Species: Marmoset (<i>Callithrix jacchus</i>)</b>	<b>male, juvenile</b>
<b><u>Case history:</u></b> Private husbandry, three animals died, apathy, low body temperature.	
<b><u>Gross pathology:</u></b> liver, lymph nodes: hyperaemia, moderate; no other gross pathology;	
<b><u>Microscopical description:</u></b>  „bacterial accumulations“	
<b><u>Pathohistological diagnosis:</u></b> <b>Hepatitis, peracute, with focal periportal necrosis.</b> <b>Nephritis, peracute, with focal tubular necrosis.</b>	
<b><u>Aetiology/Comment:</u></b>	<b>Pasteurella multocida</b>
