Case No. 26	Organ: intestine
Species: Rhesus monkey (<i>M. mulatta</i>)	male, adult
Case history: Animal from a vaccine study and experimental SIV infection (5 month p. i.); four months p.i.: animal developed recurrent diarrhoea, which was resistant to appropriate therapy	
Gross pathology: heart: suspicion of cardiomyopathy; lung: interstitial pneumonia, severe; gall bladder: enlargement of the bile duct with thickened wall; intestinal tract: signs of diarrhoea; stomach: thickened wall	
Microscopical description: Parasites (rare)	
Pathohistological diagnosis: Colitis, chronic, mild,	
Aetiology/Comment: Giardia lamblia syn. intestinalis Trichomonas sp.
