Case No. 27	Organ: intestine, liver
Species: Rhesus monkey (<i>M. mulatta</i>)	male, adult
<u>Case history:</u> Animal with an experimental SHIV infection; euthanised four months p. i. with recurrent diarrhoea	
<u>Gross pathology:</u> spleen: follicular hyperplasia, mild; small intestine: filled with very fluid content; no further abnormalities;	
<u>Microscopical description:</u> parasites	
<u>Pathohistological diagnosis:</u> Cholangitis, chronic, proliferative, eosinophilic; Enteritis, chronic, with severe villous atrophy;	
<u>Aetiology/Comment:</u> Cryptosporidium parvum • immunodeficiency!
