Case No. 43	Organ: large intestine
Species: Saddleback tamarin <i>(Saguinus fuscicollis)</i>	female, adult
Case history: Private husbandry: animal died after one week of illness; anorexia, diarrhoea, veterinary treatments without effect; suspicion: hepatitis	
Gross pathology: lymph nodes: systemic hyperplasia, moderate; lung: alveolar oedema, severe; liver: hepatopathy, severe; kidney: interstitial nephritis, moderate; large intestine: chronic colitis, severe;	
Microscopical description:	
Pathohistological diagnosis: Colitis, cystic, chronic = Colitis cystica profunda	
Aetiology/Comment:	idiopathic
