Case No. 7	Organ: CNS
Species: Baboon (<i>Papio hamdryas</i>)	female, adult
<u>Case history:</u> Experimental intracerebral application of a vaccine, animals were euthanised 20 days after infection. Clinical signs: apathy, somnolence, anorexia, progressive loss of motoric coordination.	
<u>Gross pathology:</u> No obvious changes (focal alterations at application site)	
<u>Microscopical description:</u>	
<u>Pathohistological diagnosis:</u> Encephalitis, nonsuppurative, moderate, with gliosis and neuronal degeneration	
<u>Aetiology/Comment:</u>	Oral rabies vaccine
