Case No. 8	Organ: CNS
Species: Rhesus monkey (<i>M. mulatta</i>)	female, adult
Case history: Experimental SIV infection. Due to severe anorexia the animal was euthanised three month p. i..	
Gross pathology: Generalised lymph node hyperplasia, lung: small granulomas; CNS: no abnormalities detected.	
Microscopical description: Mononuclear foamy cells, giant cells	
Pathohistological diagnosis: Encephalitis, nonsuppurative, with giant cells and gliosis, moderate to severe	
Aetiology/Comment: Simian Immunodeficiency Virus (SIV) • SIVE (SIV encephalitis)
