Case No. 9	Organ: stomach
Species: Rhesus monkey (<i>M. mulatta</i>)	male, adult
Case history: Experimental SIV infection. Euthanised due to experimental protocol. No clinical signs of any disease.	
Gross pathology: mild alveolar edema and emphysema, no further findings.	
Microscopical description: „Spirils“	
Pathohistological diagnosis: Gastritis, chronic, diffuse, moderate, with single follicles	
Aetiology/Comment: Helicobacter (H.) spec. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• (<i>H. heilmannii</i>, <i>H. pylori</i>)• Warthin-Starry; Immunohistochemistry
